


<p><u>Geography</u></p> <p>Pupils in Year 2 will explore 'Why is the weather different across the world?'</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>In computing we take part in a six-week programme to learn about digital photography.</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Our topic of 'Plants' takes children through six lessons where they learn how to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, and find out and describe how plants need water, light and suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Year 2 pupils will explore the question 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'</p>
<p><u>English</u></p> <p>In English pupils will learn to write a narrative based on the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.
