<p><u>English</u> We will secure correct letter formation and handwriting skills through writing a range of sentences and captions based around our immersion of traditional tales such as Goldilocks and the Three Bears, The Gingerbread Man.</p>	<p><u>PE</u> <u>Dance</u> The children will develop their rhythm and patterns of movement in response to music. <u>Health and Wellbeing</u> The children will develop their agility, balance and coordination skills.</p>	<p><u>Music</u> <u>Hey You!</u> 1 Pupils use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. 2 Pupils play tuned and untuned instruments musically. 3 Pupils listen with concentration and understanding to a range of high-quality live and recorded music. 4 Pupils experiment with, create, select, and combine sounds using the inter-related dimensions of music.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Our Maths learning this term will focus on: <u>Place Value</u> As mathematicians, we will learn to sort, recognise, count and compare numbers and objects to 10.</p>
<p><u>PSHE</u> <u>Me and My Relationships</u> The children will learn about the importance of classroom rules, our own and others' feelings and friendship.</p>		<p><u>DT</u> <u>Textiles: Puppets</u> As engineers, we will be learning to design and make a hand puppet by joining two pieces of material together without sewing.</p>
