

Year 3 Class Homework Grid



This grid outlines 12 different activities that your child can complete between now and February half term.

Please remember your child should continue to read their library AR books daily, practice their spellings and practice on Times table rockstars at least 3 times a week.

The following activities are all based on our current topic. The expectation is that one activity will be completed each week, but the activity is up to your child. Once they have completed one of the activities on the grid, they can colour it in. They may also wish to share it on Google Classroom or bring it into school to share with their class, **however this is not compulsory.**

Our new topic is called **'Why does Earth Matter?'**

Watch the News – has anything happened that links to the Climate or Weather? Record it and share it in anyway you like!	Try to grow your own fruit/vegetable – research one that grows well in the Autumn.	Choose a location on the globe – find out what their weather is there and compare it to ours – is it similar or different?	Visit a local allotment and see what they are growing. Make a list or poster to show what you found.	Go on a walk – what food can you see being grown?
Have a taste test day of food grown in Autumn in the UK. Rate the food tasted on a scale of 1-10.	Choose a location on the globe – find out what animals live there and why they live there. Is the climate a factor?	Make a meal with family – discuss if the food being used. Create a recipe card (share it with Mrs Wilson, she loves to try new meals!)	Create a list of jobs that require knowing the weather forecast and why they need this knowledge. e.g. Painters need to know the weather so they know if their paints will dry quickly or not or if they can paint outside.	Create a poster to represent the seasons a temperate climate has (the UK).
